SCHOLARSHIPS AND/OR FINANCIAL SUPPORT Terms

By accepting your offer of admission, you are also accepting all the conditions for maintaining this/these scholarship(s).

- The University of Ottawa is proud to offer you the Admission Scholarship, financial support that consists of two components:
 - The first component, a scholarship of \$36,000, will be credited to your student account in instalments of \$3,000 per term for the first twelve (12) consecutive terms of full-time enrolment, of the first four (4) years of study.
 - The counterpart will be paid to you in the form of research scholarships; please contact your academic unit (the program that admitted you) in order to learn about the method of payment. The total amount of the counterpart, during your studies, will be a minimum of \$84,000.

Conditions to receive and maintain your scholarships and its duration:

The duration of your scholarship is indicated on your offer of admission on the page entitled "Scholarship and/or Financial Support". Note that there are three (3) terms per academic year at the University of Ottawa: Fall, Winter and Spring/Summer. The scholarships are non-renewable.

To avoid the revocation of your scholarship, which you may then have to repay in whole or in part, you must register full-time each term for the duration of the scholarship. If you interrupt your studies, register as a part-time or special student, or withdraw from your program, your scholarship will be revoked.

For additional information on student status, please refer to the [Academic Regulation II-3](#), under section: Enrolment requirements applicable to particular categories of students. Please also take note of the section: Full-time status and paid employment, in order to meet all the conditions and maintain your full-time student status.

Should you receive a scholarship from an external source (e.g., CIHR, NSERC, SSHRC, OGS, FRQ), you will receive, or continue to receive, the first component of the Admission Scholarship. However, the second component offered by your academic unit or other internal sources will be optional for the duration of your external scholarship, while respecting obligations as per CUPE 2626 collective agreement. The total value of the second component may therefore be reduced accordingly.

If the second component of your Admission Scholarship includes a teaching assistantship, you must apply and obtain the teaching assistant position in order to receive the total amount of the second component. In addition, these positions may include a requirement that you be present on campus in Ottawa. You will need a social insurance number and a Canadian bank account in order to receive the payment from the second component.

If you submit your thesis or complete the requirements of your program prior to the end date of your scholarship, you will no longer be registered full-time, and therefore, no longer eligible to receive any remaining instalments.

Students who receive a scholarship for more than one year must submit an Annual Progress Report. An unsatisfactory progress report, will result in the annulment of your scholarship.

You may request to defer your scholarships if you obtain an approved study leave of absence.

If you fail to register for any term and have not obtained an approved study leave of absence, your scholarships will be cancelled for the given term and will automatically end, with no possibility of extension.

Scholarships may be a taxable income. No tax is deducted at the source. Failure to meet these conditions will result in the loss of your scholarships and you may have to repay, in whole or in part, any instalments you have received from the University of Ottawa during this period.
